What is the Planned Leave of Absence status for Independent study abroad participation?

The Planned Leave of Absence form lets the University know that you intend to be away for at least a semester (fall and/or spring) for non-UC study abroad.

With the Planned Leave Status, you do not need to file a Readmission Petition for the term following study abroad.

Currently registered undergraduate students who plan to participate in a recognized and accredited study abroad program for credit and who will maintain a fulltime course load during the entire term abroad are eligible to apply for Planned Leave Status.

You do not need to file a Planned Leave of Absence Form if you will be away during the summer only.

* UC transfer credit is available for programs that meet University requirements.

** UC transfer credit is available for programs that meet University requirements. UC Berkeley students participating in UC Berkeley courses on the IARU Global Summer Program are eligible for UC Berkeley course credit and financial aid.
